A fun shooting contest with our law enforcement officers challenging cowboys to the final showdown. Law enforcement can use firearms typical of their profession, a pistol or revolver, service type of rifle (no steel core ammo), and a service shotgun. No race or modified "competition" firearms. Cowboys will use their single action revolvers, side by side or pump shotgun and a lever action rifle, all cowboy guns must meet SASS (Single Action Shooting Society) regulations.

Cowboy dress is required by all cowboys and some form of police, swat or correctional officer clothing is required for police officers.

The match will consist of 6 courses of fire, three will be police oriented and three will have a cowboy theme. The mandatory safety talk is at 9:15 AM. Match location is the Thurmont Conservation and Sportsman's club, 11617 Hunt Club Rd., in Thurmont Maryland.

The match fee is \$25 and includes a prepared lunch, shooters badge and plaque to the Top Cop & Top Cowboy. All entry fees will be donated to an organization that supports widows and children of police officers and firefighters, that have fallen in the line of duty. This years donation will be sent in the name of Montgomery County Officer Noah Loetta.

The sport of Cowboy Action Shooting consists of shooting targets, many of which are steel, with live, ammunition. Participation in this sport is done so with the knowledge that shooting firearms is inherently dangerous and it is impossible to guarantee, completely, that occasional lead splatter will not enter the shooting and spectator area. Every precaution is taken by the Thurmont Conservation and Sportsman's Club (TCSC), to make this a safe sport however, we cannot be responsible for injuries or property damage caused during shooting matches. All participants and observers must wear hearing and eye protection while in the shooting area. The TCSC is not responsible for personal injuries, damage to vehicles, equipment, firearms or clothing. Unsafe behavior, improper use of firearms, failure to obey safety instructions, use of alcohol or drugs (illegal or performance hampering prescription), or failure to respond to any safety command will result in an immediate call of cease fire until the situation is rectified.

Signing this registration indicates that you agree and understand with the above conditions of the match and that you knowingly forfeit the right to hold the TCSC, its officers, workers, and/or match personnel liable for injuries or damages caused while participating in shooting events. This to include the actions of 3rd parties.
